

**NEW HANOVER TOWNSHIP  
ORDINANCE NO. 2020-03**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ARTICLE I OF THE NEW HANOVER  
TOWNSHIP CODE CHAPTER 153-18**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Township Committee of the Township of New Hanover in the County of Burlington, State of New Jersey, as follows:

**SECTION 153-18** Article I of the Codified Code of the Township of New Hanover is amended and supplemented as follows to add:

F. It shall be unlawful for any commercial business including farms to use the Municipal Dumpster.

**Invalidity.** If the provisions of any section, subsection, paragraph, or clause of this Ordinance shall be judged invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such order of judgment shall not affect or invalidate the remainder of any section, subsection, paragraph, or clause of this Ordinance.

**Severability.** All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with this Ordinance are hereby to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage and publication as provided by law.
